# Artistic Activity (2017–2025)

Since 2017, I have focused on deepening my visual language through drawing and painting, often inspired by movement and internal transformation. This period has been marked by a return to artistic authenticity, research, and the slow maturation of a personal style rooted in symbolism, body memory, and poetic abstraction.
